About Street Ghosts: Life-sized pictures of people found on Google's Street View printed and posted at the same spots where they were taken. Street Ghosts project is worldwide and already hit global cities with more than 90 posters around:

Manhattan NYC, Brooklyn NYC, Denver, Buffalo, Montreal, London, Berlin, Stuttgart, Brussels, Lyon, Marseille, Bilbao, Sydney. In the next months the project will hit the streets of San Francisco, Hong Kong, Barcelona, Amsterdam, Ljubljana and Lincoln.
